The 2009 Board of Directors meetings will be held on the 2nd Tuesday of each month, but are subject to change. Let us take a moment to highlight some of these recent accomplishments and upcoming events.

Return of the Association Family Picnic- We had a lot of great feed back from the residents that did attend. If you weren't able to attend this year visit our website and view the picnic report. Many of the children in the neighborhood enjoyed games and even a bike decorating contest. We hope to make next year's picnic even better and hope to see more residents join in. Additional work will continue in the Spring 2009 including performing safety issue related maintenance of our Association owned playground equipment.
